Small Business concerned as Labor Union Mafia marches into Canberra to install 'Smiling Assassin' Gillard

Driscoll - "The uncertainty now is who do I lobby on behalf of small business... the Rudd-Gillard Government or the State Labor Mafia Bosses sent to Canberra?"

Following the chaotic uncertainty that has engulfed the Rudd-Gillard Government, the **United Retail Federation**, a peak national industry body representing the retail sector across Australia, has indicated it's concern with the "midnight and shambolic" appointment of the new Prime Minister.

Scott Driscoll, National President of the *United Retail Federation* said that it was extremely concerning to witness the arrival of the State Labor Mafia in Canberra and the parallel removal of the democratically elected Prime Minister. Mr Driscoll added that the State Labor Mafia Bosses have proven time again how incompetent and destructive they are at the state government level and that business is very worried with the 'ominous arrival' of the "incompetent and shadowy State Labor Mafia bosses, heralding the installation of the new Prime Minister".

“The State Labor Mafia Bosses have arrived in Canberra to complete their nationwide takeover of democracy and have immediately implemented the same sort of dodgy, incompetent and knife-wielding culture we’ve seen destroy state governments,” Mr Driscoll said.

“The fact that the Rudd-Gillard Government has confirmed that it will retain the failed wastage programs, of which Ms Gillard was instrumentally involved, proves the only change has been an ominous arrival of the failed State Labor Mafia, whose incompetence and dodginess has lead to the decay of state governments and their budgets around Australia.

“This is an ominous sign for public policy in this country, an ominous sign for any future reforms and an ominous sign for small business which knows all too well the poisonous nature of the current State Labor Governments and their mafia bosses, who have jetted into Canberra to install Ms Gillard as Prime Minister.

“The continuance of the incompetent and blatantly irresponsible government spending which is putting pressure on small business and family businesses around the country has been confirmed. We are perplexed that Ms Gillard has admitted the failures of policies such as the Super Tax and then elevated its number 1 salesman to her Deputy.

“Our members in numerous surveys and polls have overwhelmingly expressed their rejection of the inflexible FairWork laws (80% against), the ETS (80% against) and the ‘SuperTax’ (90% against) but the Rudd-Gillard government refuses to listen to family businesses in Main Street Australia.

“At a time where small business needs certainty and real action we are now extremely concerned with the arrival of the dodgy and incompetent State Labor Mafia Bosses heralding in the installation of the new Prime Minister

“This is a backward step for small business, a backward step for jobs growth and a backward step for democracy in Australia,” Mr Driscoll said.
